PUBLIC NOTICE

April 7, 2014

On Wednesday April 16, 2014 at 8:30 PM at the start of the Town Board's regular meeting a public information discussion will be held regarding removal of a water storage tank owned by New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) located on Town owned property on Beaver Dam Road. The meeting will be at the Bedford Town House, 321 Bedford Road, Bedford Hills NY 10507 and will be led by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), which is providing guidance on the removal, and DOCCS.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the Town Board, neighbors and other interested parties about the tank removal. The project includes remediation of lead contaminated soil on the property. The lead contamination exists from removal of previous tank exterior coatings which contained lead. The project is scheduled to begin in mid 2014.

The project will be administered and paid for by DOCCS. Following project completion, the area will be tested and restored with top soil and seed. The Town will not incur any financial cost on the project.

Attached is a fact sheet prepared by DEC in September 2013. The fact sheet was provided to interested parties in 2013 through DEC's communication protocol, which DEC will describe at the April 16 meeting. Although the fact sheet states that the public comment period has expired, DEC and DOCCS will be available at the meeting to respond to any public comments.
