**Rights of Crime Victims**

**Your Right to Certain Kinds of Compensation and Assistance:**

The New York State Crime Victims Board may be able to reimburse you for your direct out-of-pocket expenses caused by the crime. These expenses may include the repair or replacement of essential personal property, loss of earnings or support, medical bills including the cost of counseling, vocational rehabilitation, crime scene cleanup or funeral bills.

A claim form can be obtained from a police station, sheriff's office, District Attorney's (DA) office, local victim advocate's office, hospital emergency room, or by requesting one from the Crime Victims Board website:
