

Lot 3 Repaving August 27 – August 31

Paving and striping will be done in phases from August 27 – August 31 resulting in at least a 50% reduction of metered and permit parking spaces each day.


All metered parking
is first come, first served.

Twenty additional metered parking spaces
only become available after 10am
in Lot 1, 2 Jay Street.

Only Lot 3 annual permit holders will be able to use
Lot 2, 190 Katonah Avenue, permit parking
as overflow parking during the repaving project.

Overnight parking from August 26 – August 31 is
discouraged as it may result in your car being towed.




NOTICE TO PARKING LOT #3 PATRONS

The Town of Bedford Public Works Department is going to be paving Parking Lot #3 located on Woods Bridge Road. This is to occur over a 5 day period beginning Mon. August 27, 2012 to Thurs. August 30, 2012 (weather permitting.) The schedule is as follows:

- On Mon. August 27, 2012 the upper lot will closed to the public and will be paved (the lower lot will remain open to public parking.)
- On Tue. August 28, 2012 the upper lot will continue to be closed to the public and parking spaces will be striped with paint (the lower lot will remain open to public parking.)
- On Wed. August 29, 2012 the lower lot will be closed to the public and will be paved (the upper lot will be opened for public parking.)
- On Thurs. August 30, 2012 the lower lot will continue to be closed to the public and parking spaces will be striped with paint (the upper lot will remain open for public parking.)
- On Fri. August 31, 2012 the lower lot will re-open for public parking.

A diagram is provided below. Much of this work depends on the weather and the project may take a few days longer to accomplish.
