A public hearing was held by the Town Board of the Town of Bedford on September 6, 2011 at the Town Offices, 321 Bedford Road, Bedford Hills, New York to consider Local Law #6/2011 to amend Chapter 117, Article II of the Code of the Town of Bedford regarding parking and traffic regulation. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Supervisor Roberts.

Proof of publication was presented and ordered filed. The public notice was published in the Bedford Pound Ridge Record Review on August 26, 2011.

Mr. Winn explained that this amendment was to change the yield sign at the intersection of Bedford Center Road with Route 22 at the Bedford Cross, to a stop sign. Chief Hayes commented he had no issues with this change.

The Town Board acknowledged the receipt of an email from a resident of Bedford Center Road in support of the proposed change and one resident was present that voiced their support.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Bedford Amends Chapter 117, Article II of the Code of the Town of Bedford regarding Parking and Traffic Regulations as follows:

§ 117-2. Main arteries of travel.

The following streets listed under Column A below are hereby designated as main arteries of travel, and all vehicles, before entering same from public highways set forth opposite same as listed under Column B below, shall come to a full stop or yield the right-of-way as indicated by signs, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal:
