A public hearing was held by the Town Board of the Town of Bedford was held on July 16, 2013 at the Town House, 321 Bedford Road, Bedford Hills, New York to consider Local Law #4-2013 an amendment to Chapter 117 of the Code of the Town of Bedford concerning vehicles and traffic. The meeting was called to order at 7:45 P.M. by Supervisor Roberts.

Proof of Publication was presented and ordered filed. The public notice was published in the Bedford Pound Ridge Record Review on July 5, 2013.

Mrs. Roberts explained that this was an update to the ordinance to allow parking on Valley Road in Katonah during religious events that took place at time other than Sunday, like the Saturday evening services at St. Mary's Church and other religious events such as weddings and funeral that might occur at the local churches. She asked that those attending the services respect the neighbors on the streets around the church and not block the road or park in front of driveways.

Mrs. Roberts opened the floor to public comment.

Members of the St. Mary's congregation expressed appreciation for the Town's quick response to their concerns and advised of their willingness to cooperate with the Town other community groups.

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 -2013 LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 117
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF BEDFORD

A LOCAL LAW to amend Chapter 117of the Code of the Town of Bedford concerning vehicles and traffic

July 16, 2013 – Public Hearing - continued

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Bedford as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 117 of the Code of the Town of Bedford, titled “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” is hereby amended as follows:

§117-1. Enumeration of restrictions and restricted areas.

C. At Katonah:

Name of Street	Side	Time Limit; Hours/Days	Location
Valley Road	Both	2hrs; --	From Katonah Avenue to Bedford Road
Valley Road	North	--; except Sundays <u>and</u> <u>during religious services</u>	At Valley Edge
Valley Road	North	--; except Sundays <u>and</u> <u>during religious services</u>	From the driveway of the Presbyterian Church east to Bedford Road
Valley Road	North	4hrs; --	From Valley Edge to Edgemont Road
Valley Road	South	--	From New Street easterly for a distance of 375 feet
Valley Road	South	--; except Sundays <u>and</u> <u>during religious services</u>	From New Street to Valley Edge

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.

There being no further discussion the hearing was adjourned at 7:58 pm.
