Dear Parents,

The Town of Bedford Recreation Department is looking ahead to our summer programs and wanted to inform you of your camp options for those campers entering 7 – 9 grades in the fall (These campers are currently in 6 - 8 grades). The following programs are available:

1. Teen Travel Camp- TEEN GET-A-WAY is for those entering 7-9 grades in the Fall 2015(Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)
Price \$ 1,050

OR

2. Teen Travel- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, with the option to attend the Town Camp Monday and Friday (for those entering 7th grade in the fall of 2015)
Price \$ 1,150 plus pool pass

OR

3. Teen Travel- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, with the option to apply to be a CIT Monday and Friday (for those entering 9th grade in the fall of 2015)
Price \$ 1,050

OR

4. Town Day Camp is for those entering grades 1-7 in the fall of 2016.

The Teen Travel Registration takes place on January 30. In order to register for Teen Travel you must complete a Registration Form (with immunizations), and give a \$200 deposit (Check or Cash only). \$100 of the deposit is **non-refundable**. All fees for Teen Travel must be paid by June 1. **No** registration forms will be given out prior to the day of registration. You may only register your own children unless arrangements have been made with the Town of Bedford Recreation and Parks Department prior to the start of registration.

Regular Day Camp Registration will begin in March. Information will be in our on-line Spring Summer Brochure available for viewing on our Town website, www.bedfordny.gov in the beginning of March.

Please note that our Full Time CIT program does not start until teens have completed 9th grade.

General Information for Teen Get-A-Way

Dates, Times and Location:

Teen Get A-Way will meet Tuesday Wednesday Thursday from July 5 - August 11th. Our camper drop off/pick up location is the Bedford Hills Community House.

Staff and supervision:

Westchester County Department of Health requires Day camps to maintain a counselor/ camper ratio of 1:12. Teen Get A-Way will maintain a 1:10 ratio, staff to teens. All Staff must attend pre-camp orientation training. The Camp Director will be certified in CPR for the Professional Rescuer and Responding to Emergencies (First Aid).
