

## SUMMER EMPLOYMENT AT OUR TOWN POOLS **NEW**

### LIFEGUARDS

Bedford Recreation & Parks is pleased to announce that we will be hiring a limited number of 15 year old lifeguards, who have the proper certifications, at our 3 pool facilities this summer. Certified lifeguards 16 and older are also welcome to apply. **PLEASE NOTE:** per New York State & Westchester County Health Department regulations, all municipal pool lifeguards **MUST** renew their CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer yearly even though your certification may state it is valid for 2 years – it is only valid for 1 year to work at a municipal pool facility.




## TINY DRAGONS



## A Message from the TOWN CLERK

Please be reminded that all users of the Canine Commons Dog Park **MUST** have a valid park permit that is issued by the Town Clerk's Office. Permits are available to Town of Bedford residents for a fee. A limited number of non resident permits are issued every year for the dog park. Dogs using the Canine Commons area must have a New York State license and a valid dog park permit issued through the Town Clerks office. The Town Clerks office is located at the Town House, 321 Bedford Road in Bedford Hills. The office hours are Monday through Friday 8:30am to 4:30pm (and for residents after hours by appointment). The telephone number for the Town Clerks office is 666-4534.

**Please note: The park is checked on a regular basis by the Bedford Police Department and Dog Control Officer. Fines for non permit holders can be as high as \$250.00. Permit holders are reminded to display their valid permit in the designated drivers side, side windows.**

### BEAVER DAM PARK – Home of the Canine Commons

*Beaver Dam Road off of Harris Road Bedford Hills*

Located on Beaver Dam Road off of Harris Road in Bedford Hills. It features the Canine Commons Dog area that officially opened in the spring of 2008. This 1.5+ acre site features three separate areas that are fully enclosed with fencing. There is a small dog area (under 30 lbs), large dog area (over 30 lbs) and an agility area. Use of the Canine Commons area is open to Town of Bedford residents who are licensed and have a valid dog park permit.

# DOG PARK RULES

-  All dogs must be licensed, have a valid Town of Bedford permit, current with all inoculations, healthy and wearing a collar with identification at all times – *Contact the Bedford Town Clerk for licensing and permitting information (914-666-4534). Any dog using the park without proper license/permit will be issued a fine and future access to the facility will be prohibited*
-  Dogs must be leashed upon entering/exiting the enclosures
-  Owners must be in the enclosure keeping their dog in view and in voice control at all times
-  Leaving dogs unattended is prohibited
-  Eating/smoking/picnicking is not permitted in the enclosures at any time

### **OWNERS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOGS AND DISPOSE WASTE IN THE RECEPTACLES PROVIDED**

-  Dogs exhibiting aggression are not permitted – Owners must remove their dog
-  Dogs must be discouraged from digging – Owners must fill any holes their dog digs
-  Dogs must be discouraged from excessive/constant barking – Owners must control or remove their dog
-  Dogs who are ill, injured or in heat, as well as puppies under 4 months old, are all prohibited
-  Limit is 3 dogs per person per visit
-  The dog park is not recommended for children – Children age 12 and under must be supervised
-  Be cautious with dog toys, some don't like to share
-  The use of Dog treats as a snack or reward is NOT permitted within the fenced areas of the park

**Non-compliance with these rules will result in expulsion from the Dog Park. Decision for expulsion will be made by the Superintendent of Recreation & Parks in conjunction with the Town Clerk and Dog Control Officer**

**For the benefit of everyone in our community, please remember to leave our dog park nicer than you found it! ~ thank you!**

*PLEASE NOTE: Some of the above rules may be temporarily suspended when Town-approved programs or training is being conducted at the park.*

*Any person bringing a dog into this facility assumes the legal responsibility, jointly and severally, with the owner of the dog, for any damage, disease or injury to persons, other dogs or property, caused by the dog. All persons using the facility, by entering it, agree to indemnify the Town of Bedford and hold the Town harmless for any harm resulting from the use of this facility.*

*Any incident, problem, violation, emergency, etc. must be reported immediately to the Bedford Dog Control Officer, 914-666-4855, or to the Bedford Police Department, 914-241-3111 or 911.*

Opened and dedicated on July 4, 1920, this charming building was gifted to the Town of Bedford in 2001 by the Bedford Hills Community House Association. Presently, the building is maintained by the Building Department maintenance staff with scheduling of the building performed by the Recreation and Parks Department. Schedule permitting, there are a variety of rooms available for use/rent. You must be a Town of Bedford resident to reserve/rent space in the building. ### **MAIN ROOM**

**\*2016 Rental rate is \$420.00 for a 6 hour block of time. (1 hour set up 4 hour event 1 hour clean up) This includes an on site building supervisor. A security deposit of \$250.00 is required.**

### **LOWER LEVEL LEGION ROOM**

Located in the basement / lower level, the Legion Room accommodates **50 people for a meeting or 40-45 for parties**. Tables & chairs. Use of the kitchen is included in the rental fee.

**\*2016 Rental rate is \$55.00 per hour and can be booked in ½ or 1 hour blocks of time. A building supervisor is not provided. Security deposit of \$100.00 is required.**

### **LOUNGE MEETING ROOM**

Located on the main floor, the Lounge Meeting Room accommodates up to **16 people**. Features a 35" TV and a DVD player and is air conditioned.



### **BOARD MEETING ROOM**

Located on the main floor, the Board Meeting Room accommodates up to **16 people**. Features a wall mounted 52" flat screen TV with DVD player. Connects to sun room for dual room use if desired. Air conditioned.

### **SUN MEETING ROOM**

Located on the main floor, the Sun Meeting Room accommodates up to **14 people**. The room is accessible through exterior side doors or through the Board Room. Air conditioned.

# registration & program information



## ON-LINE REGISTRATION HAS ARRIVED!

**Registration for fall  
programs, can be done on-line!**

To utilize on-line registration you will need a user name & password. If you are an active household in our system you were emailed a household ID user name and password in the spring. The first time you login to register you will use the user name & password you are emailed. Once you have accessed the system you will be able to reset your user name and password. To begin, simply log onto our website at [www.bedfordny.gov](http://www.bedfordny.gov) and go to the Recreation & Parks page and click on the online registration button to get started. If you did not receive our email please give us a call at 666-7004.

\*When you log on to the site, please make sure you review & update all information in the system pertaining to your household and each of your family members. Please pay particular attention to items such as phone numbers, emergency contact information and the primary e-mail address you would like associated with your account. Please note not all information can be changed (ie; birth-dates) and should you need to change that information or add a family member or have questions please give us a call – 666-7004.

If you are new to the area or to our programs, and don't have an existing household account and would like to create a household account, please visit our website at [www.bedfordny.gov](http://www.bedfordny.gov) and go to the Recreation & Parks page and click on the online registration button to get started. You will be prompted with what you will need to provide in order to prove residency/eligibility.

**NOTE: ALL CREDIT/DEBIT TRANSACTIONS WILL  
BE CHARGED A 2.5% TRANSACTION FEE**

## PROGRAM REGISTRATION

Registration, both on-line registration and in person, will begin on the same date, at the same time and will occur simultaneously. Registrations by mail will be processed upon receipt but not before the first date of registration. Please note we do not confirm program registration nor can we be responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Mail in/office location is: Bedford Recreation, 425 Cherry St., Bedford Hills, NY 10507.

## NON-RESIDENT REGISTRATION

Non-residents are eligible to enroll in most general recreation programs the Town offers at a 25% surcharge. Not all programs are open to non-residents.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS /CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS

Payment can be made by cash, money order, check (payable to Town of Bedford) or credit card. Credit card payment can be done in person or on-line. Please be advised that all credit card or affiliated debit card charges will incur an additional 2.5% charge that is passed onto the user/card holder. This includes ALL ON-LINE & IN PERSON TRANSACTIONS using your credit/debit card. This fee is not reflected on your Town of Bedford receipt but will appear on your credit card or bank statement.

## REFUNDS

The Town of Bedford refunds under the following conditions:

- A full refund will be given if the program is cancelled by the Recreation & Parks Department prior to the start of the program.
- If the program participant moves from the Town, a full or pro-rated refund will be made based on the number of sessions attended. Proof of relocation must be presented.
- If a participant becomes ill or injured, a full or prorated refund will be made based on the number of sessions the participant attended. A doctor's note must accompany the request.

There is a \$10.00 processing fee for all refunds that are approved except for programs that are cancelled by the Recreation Department. All refund requests must be made directly to the Superintendent of Recreation & Parks.

\*Teen-Get-Away Camp and Tiny Tots/Day Camps have separate refund policies.

## RETURNED CHECKS

There is a \$35.00 fee for any returned checks.

## INSURANCE

The Town of Bedford carries standard liability coverage. This coverage does not include medical costs for anyone injured in the normal course of participation in any Town program. All individuals enrolled in Town of Bedford Recreation & Parks programs do so at their own risk.

## SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNTS

The minimum age for a senior citizen for program enrollment discounts\* is age 65. This is for all Recreation & Parks Department sponsored programs and does not apply to joining the Bedford Seniors Club; Town of Bedford Refuse Program or Westchester County Park Passes where the age remains at 60.

\*Not all programs offer discounts.

\*Discounts are for TOB resident seniors only

## **E-Z Pass** New York Service Center

Easy Pass is now available in the Town Clerk's office, Monday - Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

It's as easy as 1-2-3! This is an innovative program to obtain an E-Z Pass tag which allows the busy traveler to open an E-Z Pass account without waiting for it to come in the mail or wait on a line.

Just come to the Clerk's office with \$25.00 and you will be able to use it when you leave. Stop by or call 666-4534 for more information.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

No Town of Bedford resident will be denied participation in any recreation program solely because of an inability to pay the prescribed fee. The Town of Bedford & Town Board is committed to providing recreation opportunities to residents of all ages without regard to economic circumstances. For scholarship consideration, please contact the Superintendent of Recreation and Parks at 666-7004

### **PROGRAM CANCELLATIONS**

Notification on program cancellations are made via email alerts. If you haven't provided us with an email please do so upon registering or call us at 666-7004 to make sure we have it on file. Notification will also be made on our hotline number 864-3777. Generally, programs are not held when school is not in session. Postponed classes are made up at the end of the program session if time allows.

### **HOW TO WATCH A GOOD PROGRAM DIE**

Please register early! Nothing kills a recreation program faster than residents who wait until the last minute to register. All programs require a high level of coordination including facility scheduling, staffing and volunteer recruitment and purchasing of supplies. There is a point when a program must be cancelled or modified if there is insufficient registration.

### **FIELD AND FACILITY PERMITS**

Permits are required for group use of our fields/facilities. You must be a Town of Bedford resident to reserve a field/facility. For a facility use application with fee schedule please call our office at 666-7004 or download an application from the "Forms and Applications" section on the Town website, [www.bedfordny.gov](http://www.bedfordny.gov). Applications must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the scheduled activity.
