Step 1 You need to provide, along with this application, a copy of the most recent Notice of Non-Compliance issued by the Westchester County Department of Health that your septic system was found in failure. You can the Mount Kisco office of the Health Department at 914-224-7656 for a copy of this Notice.

Step 2 Contact Joe Mancini of the Westchester County Department of Health at 914-224-7656 BEFORE any repair, remediation or replacement work is performed to ensure that prior approval or inspection of such work is properly coordinated with the Department of Health.

Step 3 Septic contractor completes the work and receives final approval or inspection by the Health Department.

Step 4 Supply the following to the Town of Bedford, attention: Jeffrey Osterman, Director of Planning, 425 Cherry Street, Bedford Hills, NY 10507 or josterman@bedfordny.gov:

- a. Septic contractor's contract for the work approved by the Health Department.
- b. Evidence of payment to the contractor.
- c. Health Department final approval or inspection report.

Step 5 The Town of Bedford will issue a check for 50% of the approved repair, remediation or replacement.
